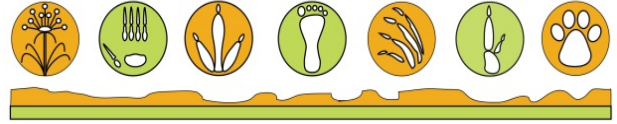

2017 Raft Race Rules

1. Rafts:

- Any raft may join the race.
- Canoes, kayaks, yachts, boats may not enter.
- The above craft may NOT form the hull of the raft.
- Rafts will be inspected.

2. Minimum of 6 and maximum of 8 people per raft.

- Each member should know how to swim or if not wear their own life vest.

3. Teams are encouraged to register at least a day before the event.

- Late comers may be permitted in some instances.

4. All team members MUST read and sign the '**Assumption of Risks, Complete Release of liability and Water/Swimming Activities Waiver**'.

- The forms should be returned together with the entry form.

5. Propulsion:

- Mechanical propulsion devices are NOT allowed to be incorporated into the design nor held by the members of the team i.e. no motors, propellers etc.
- One (1) hand-held paddle per person.
 - Oars are NOT allowed in the race.

(N.B.) The difference between oars and paddles are that paddles are held by the paddler, and are not connected with the vessel. Oars connected to the raft will be disqualified.

6. Judges decisions are final.

7. In the interest of the environment of Lake Mary Ann, participants of the race are asked to follow these guidelines:

- No detergents.
 - Water based dyes and biodegradable materials to be used.
 - Water bombs allowed.
 - No eggs.

8. Lifeguards will be provided ONLY during the raft race.
