In response to recent vicious dog attacks during the past six weeks, Barkly Regional Council (BRC) is initiating a proactive strategy to address roaming and menacing dogs. This program is in partnership with visiting Alice Springs Town Council rangers.

Council would like to remind dog owners and residents of the following:

- ☐ **All dogs must be suitably contained at all times**
- ☐ **All dogs must be registered**
- ☐ **Only two dogs per household**

**BRC and the vet, who is co-located at the Council Depot, 1 Maloney Street, will provide FREE surgical desexing, parasite treatment and micro-chipping of dogs and cats from Monday, 20 July to Friday, 24 July. Pups will be vaccinated for FREE.**

Council will also remove any aggressive and wandering dogs, including rehoming where possible, in accordance with animal control policies.
