

PREAMBLE




The underlying principle of good law is that it must serve people and communities, avoiding impositions not directly related to the good order, safety, health and welfare of those people and communities. The Barkly Shire is a large area of the Northern Territory with a small, dispersed population living in varying circumstances and having different needs. What may be necessary, achievable and appropriate in one place or situation may not be so in another.

The Barkly Shire By Laws will be enforced in a way that is consistent with the laws of the Northern Territory and the Commonwealth. Enforcement will be exercised using appropriate discretion taking into account local circumstances and conditions while maintaining personal and community safety, health and welfare.
